MASONS BAY

Shire camping, barbeque, toilets, fishing, swimming, pets permitted

MASONS POINT

Whale watching, FQM mine seawater pipeline

TWELVE MILE

Swimming, surfing, fishing, snorkelling, toilets

FIVE MILE

Fishing

TWO MILE

Barbeque, toilets, fishing, surfing, beach combing

HOPETOUN BEACH

Toilets, water, showers, barbeques, boat ramp, jetty, swimming pontoons in summer, fishing

WEST BEACH

Toilets, fishing, beach combing

FOUR MILE

DPaW Camping, barbeques, toilets, swimming, fishing, whale watching

BARRENS BEACH

Snorkelling, beach combing, fishing, toilets

EAST MYLIES & MYLIES

Walking, fishing, whale watching, surfing

CAVE POINT

Walking, whale watching, look out

WEST BEACH

Fishing, surfing

HAMERSLEY

Shire camping, barbeque, toilets, fishing, nature study, 4WD'ing & sandboarding in dunes, boat access to inlet

WHALEBONE

Backpack camping

QUOIN HEAD

4WD only, DPaW camping, toilets, barbeque, swimming, fishing, walking

- 1 The sports complex has football, hockey, cricket, bowls, tennis, basketball and netball.
- 2 Ambulance, Fire and Marine Rescue volunteer service stations
- 3 This area includes Hopetown Hall and the adjacent Rural Transaction Centre which includes the Medical Centre, Hopetown Progress Association and the Community Resource Centre (telecentre) with public library, broadband internet and visitor information.
- 4 Mary Ann Haven includes the Police Station, Senior Citizens Centre, and Community Health and Aged Care services.
- 5 McCulloch Park has playground, bandstand, BBQ, shelters and toilets. It was once a loading and warehouse area for the former railway and jetty.
- 6 The Hopetown - Ravensthorpe Railway Heritage Trail closely follows sections of the line of the former mineral and passenger railway (1909 - 1935). Brochures obtainable from local tourist centres.
- 7 All beaches are good for swimming in crystal clear blue water. Usually the most sheltered water for children is just west of the groynne. Two-Mile Beach is a sheltered corner with sand and flat rocks.
- 8 Beach launching ramp for small boats.
- 9 The groynne has a jetty and a hard launching ramp with catwalk.
- 10 Captain Douglas lookout has a viewing platform with picnic table, giving fine views of Hopetown and the western coast, good for sunsets.
- 11 Mary Ann Waters Estate in west Hopetown is projected for further development.
